*Fun Fact: When Alaska became a state in 1959 the lyrics had to be changed from “largest and grandest” to “boldest and grandest.”*

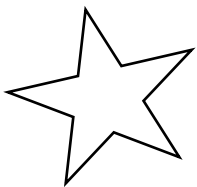
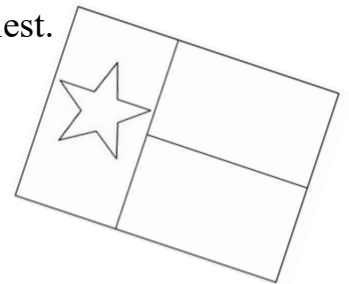
### “Texas, Our Texas”
