



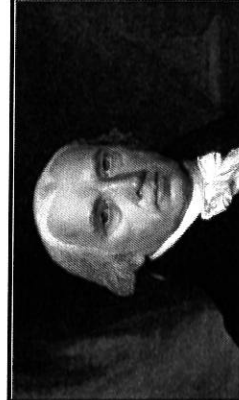
Name: Garrett Morgan

 Lifetime: 1822-1913
 Best Escaped from slavery
 Known For:
 Fun Fact: She went back to the South 13 more times and rescued 70 people



Name: Rosa Parks
 Lifetime: 1913-2005
 Best Refused to give up her seat, and started the Montgomery Bus Boycott
 Known For: seat, and started the Montgomery Bus Boycott
 Fun Fact: She was not the first to refuse to give up her seat



Name: James Madison
 Lifetime: 1751-1836
 Best Father of the U.S.
 Known For: Constitution
 Fun Fact: He is considered the most successful Founding Father



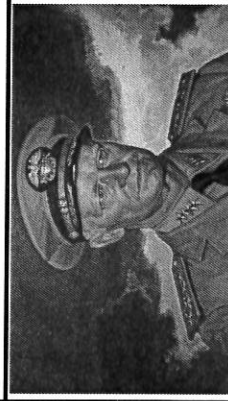
Name: Stephen F. Austin
 Lifetime: 1793-1836
 Best He brought the first Anglo settlers to Texas
 Known For: Anglo settlers to Texas
 Fun Fact: He left his entire estate to his sister - not to her husband



Name: Madame C.J. Walker

 Best She started the Madam C.J. Walker Manufacturing Company
 Known For: C.J. Walker
 Fun Fact: She was born Sarah Breedlove, she was one of six children



Name: Ellen Ochoa
 Lifetime: 1958-
 Best First Hispanic woman in space
 Known For: space
 Fun Fact: She is trained as a classical flutist



Name: Chester W. Nimitz
 Lifetime: 1885-1966
 Best Selected as the commander-in-chief, United States Pacific Fleet in World War II
 Known For: commander-in-chief, United States Pacific Fleet in World War II
 Fun Fact: He is from Fredericksburg, Texas



Name: James Cook
 Lifetime: 1728-1779
 Best First European to land on the Hawaiian Islands
 Known For: on the Hawaiian Islands
 Fun Fact: He named them the Sandwich Islands



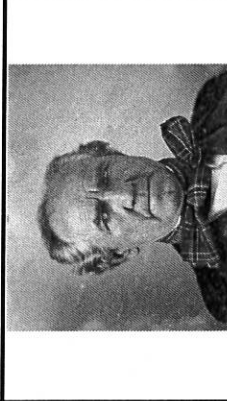
Name: Napoleon Bonaparte
 Lifetime: 1769-1821
 Best Becoming the first Emperor of France after the French Revolution
 Known For: Emperor of France after the French Revolution
 Fun Fact: He was actually of average height for the time



Name: Bessie Coleman
 Lifetime: 1892-1926
 Best First woman of African American (and Native American) decent to have a pilots license
 Known For: American (and Native American) decent to have a pilots license
 Fun Fact: She had to go to France to get her license



Name: Miriam A. Ferguson
 Lifetime: 1875-1961
 Best First female governor of Texas
 Known For: Texas
 Fun Fact: Her husband wasn't allowed to run for political office



Name: Sam Houston
 Lifetime: 1793-1863
 Best First President of the Republic of Texas
 Known For: Republic of Texas
 Fun Fact: He is the only American to have been governor of two different states



Name: Alice Paul
 Lifetime: 1885-1977
 Best Helped organize the campaigns that led to women gaining the right to vote
 Known For: campaigns that led to women gaining the right to vote
 Fun Fact: She was arrested 7 times in England and at least once in the US



Name: Marie Sklodowska Curie
 Lifetime: 1867-1934
 Best Only person to have won two Nobel Prizes
 Known For: won two Nobel Prizes
 Fun Fact: She won her first Nobel Prize with her husband, and another scientist
