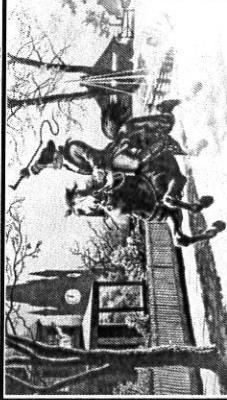


Name: Anson Jones

 Fun Fact: He wanted to be a printer, but instead he became a doctor.



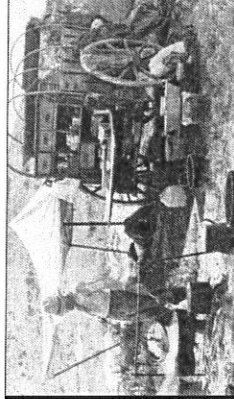
Name: Benjamin Franklin

Fun Fact: He developed a new alphabet that got rid of redundant consonants

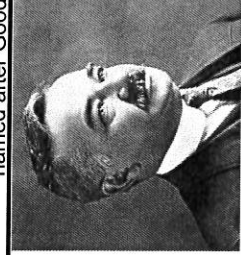


Name: Paul Revere

Fun Fact: He was a very well known silversmith

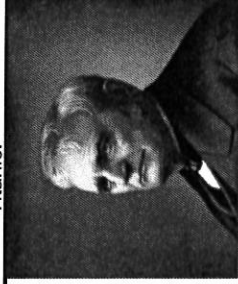


Name: Charles Goodnight

Fun Fact: He was almost on the fateful voyage of the Titanic.



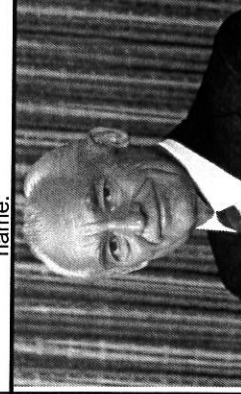
Name: John Deere

 Fun Fact: Henry Ford has 161 unique patents to his name.



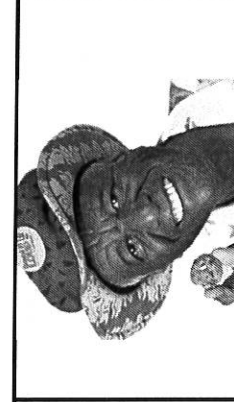
Name: Sam Walton

 Fun Fact: He worked as a talent agent and signed Simon & Garfunkel



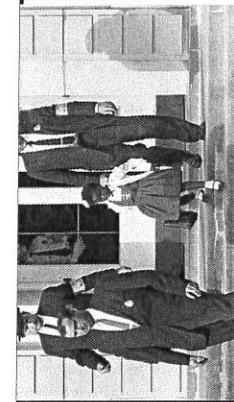
Name: Karl Benz

Fun Fact: The first long distance automobile trip was taken by his wife Bertha

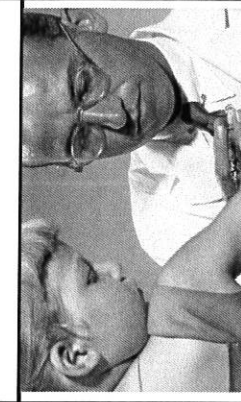


Name: Joseph Glidden

Fun Fact: The sharp barbs keep cows from leaning on the fence and breaking it

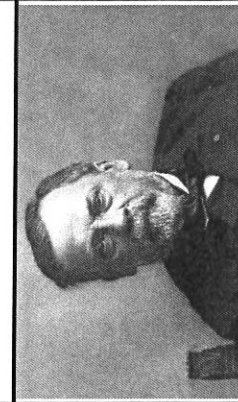


Name: Ruby Bridges
 Lifetime: 1954-

Name: Jonas Salk
 Lifetime: 1914-1995
 Best Discovered and developed one of the first polio vaccines

Name: Louis Pasteur
 Lifetime: 1822-1895
 Best He invented the process of pasteurization - to kill germs in milk and wine
